Dear Fellow Hornet:

The Fairmont Heights High School Alumni Association was established and has been committed to supporting our Alma Mater, the students who matriculate through the doors of the high school, and the staff. We have provided thousands of dollars to the school since 1989 through our fundraising efforts that include selling paraphernalia at school activities and our Spring Scholarship Dance. We have continued to volunteer our time and services to support the students, administration and staff in raising monies for scholarships, resources and school needs that the Central Office has not provided for adequately in the budget and individual school organizations.

However, our fundraising efforts have been severely curtailed with the presence of COVID-19. As you can imagine since schools have been closed our paraphernalia sales have dropped off tremendously and we cancelled the Spring Dance for 2020 which generally brought in over \$3000 profit which we used to award scholarships. The times are still uncertain, so the Ways & Means Committee has voted unaimously to cancel the Spring Dance for 2021, but we still want to provide assistance to those who plan to further their education beyond high school.

We are hopeful that you may be in the position to provide a suggested contribution of \$25 or more, if able. For first time members and renewing members who contribute \$25 or more, \$10 goes to a one-year membership and the balance to the scholarship fund. We know that times are difficult for all, but if you can find it in your pocket to contribute, "We Thank-You!" Any and all contributions will be appreciated.
